### Sampson Veterans Cemetery

The cemetery, on the eastern side of Seneca Lake, is on the site of the World War II era Sampson Naval Training Station and the 1950s Sampson Air Force Base. The idea of the cemetery came from Navy and Air Force veterans who were stationed at Sampson and later established a museum there. Planning for the cemetery began in 2002 and broke ground a year ago. The first veteran is expected to be buried there in the fall of 2010.

# Field of Honor Fact Sheet

The 4th Annual Veterans Field of Honor at Seneca Lake State Park, Geneva, New York, located on Routes 5 & 20 east of Geneva will take place from **November 6-11, 2010**

*There will be at least 2,000 flags* representing those servicemen and servicewomen who lost their lives in wars past and present. We also want to pay tribute to those servicemen and servicewomen who continue to represent America in their mission to preserve democracy and to protect our freedom.

The flags are 3' x 5' printed American flags and Branch of Service flags flown on 8 foot poles. *Each flag will be labeled with the name of the individual that it honors or memorializes.* At the conclusion of the Veterans Field of Honor event, the flag and the pole will be given back to the purchaser for their own use. Flags cost \$30. The flag can be picked up November 11, 2010, Noon to 7 PM or mailed for an additional \$5.00. Flags not retrieved will be donated accordingly.

**FLAGS: Citizens and businesses are invited** to sponsor a flag to be flown on the Veterans Field of Honor either in memory of individuals who served or in honor of those who are serving in their country and/or community.

**The official Ceremony will be at noon on Saturday, November 6, 2010.**

The program will include a color guard, reading of the names, guest speaker and music featuring patriotic songs.
